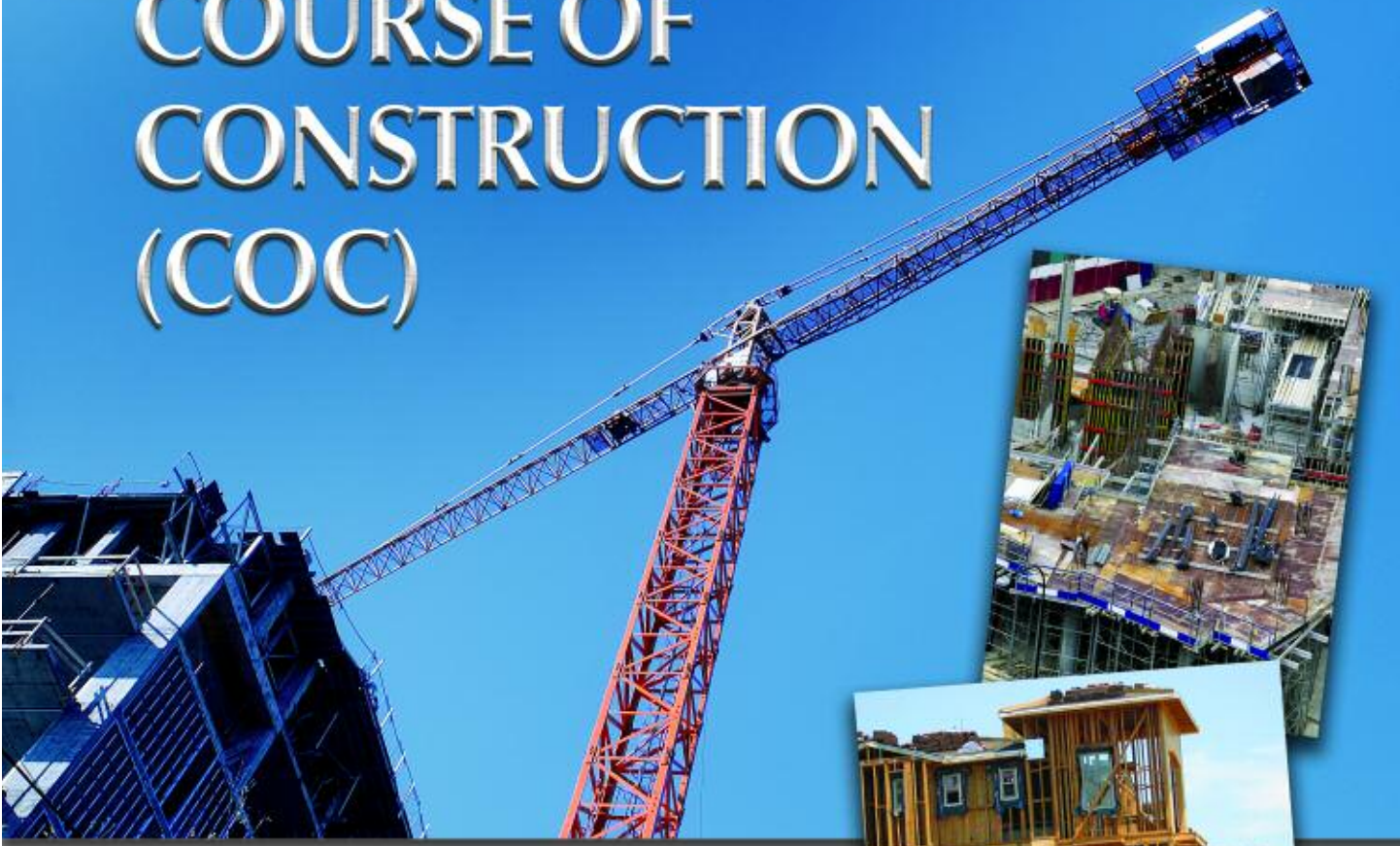


COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION (COC)
